

Daycamp Evaluation Form

Please read thoroughly and initial:

Safety is our primary goal, therefore; ***Daycamp Is Not For Every Dog. Please reflect upon the following when considering your dog for a daycamp evaluation.*** Daycamp is not a place for aggressive dogs to learn how to be social. To be accepted into our Daycamp program, all dogs must successfully pass a physical and behavioral assessment before being approved. Dog(s) must be tolerant to all staff for handling and interaction. While your dog might be playful, they also must be deemed for “safe play” while in camp. Daycamp may not be the best fit for a pet that suffers from anxiety, and depending on severity is not recommended for pets with physical ailments. Any signs of unwarranted aggression towards staff or Daycamp attendees will not be accepted. Please note that our day camp experiences capacities of 25+ dogs a day. Owners must accurately detail any prior experience at other Daycamp facilities or history involving their pet below on the form. The Barkley reserves the right to refuse dogs that have displayed aggression, anxiety, and/or problematic behavior such as lack of recall and mounting. Your dog will attend either large or small camp depending on size and demeanor.

Additional requirements to attend our Daycamp Program:

1. Complete the Pet Profile and Evaluation Form
2. After 6 M/O must be spayed or neutered
3. Be at least 16 weeks of age and meet our vaccination requirements: complete full series of (Rabies, DHPP, Bordetella, CIV, and Leptospirosis vaccinations)
4. Meet our behavioral & temperament standards
5. Complete & Pass Daycamp Evaluation- Depending on your dog, the evaluation process may require an “Ongoing Evaluation” which would require an assessment over the course of several trials
6. If your pet passed an evaluation but it has been a year or more since attending camp we require a re-evaluation. This is treated the same as an evaluation to ensure they are still fit for “safe play” with the current group of campers.

Daycamp Evaluation Fee= \$45- (duration of evaluation time may vary)

Overnight Guests wishing to attend Daycamp must be accepted for Daycamp prior to their first day of overnight stay. Clients are strongly encouraged to make reservations for their dogs to attend Daycamp. Daycamp is limited in size, so please book ahead to avoid disappointment. Priority goes to clients with standing reservations. We request 24-hour notification for cancellation.

Assumption Of Risk: Owner acknowledges and is aware that the employees of The Barkley are not veterinarians and do not have backgrounds in animal medicine and are not expected to diagnose or detect illnesses in the dogs utilizing Services at The Barkley. Owner understands that the Service's leash-free environment allows dogs the opportunity to play in close physical contact (including nose-to-nose) with each other. As a result, no amount of vaccination requirement, supervision, sanitation, or personalized care from The Barkley can be 100% certain to prevent a Dog from being injured or contracting an airborne virus or communicable disease. Despite these precautions, Owner understands these are risks inherent to the services and hereby releases The Barkley, its employees or members or other agents, from any and all losses, damages, costs and expenses arising out of or in connection with any injury, communicable disease, airborne virus, or any other medical condition contracted by owner's dog at The Barkley. This also applies to any claims for injuries or damages relate to such medical care or transport. Furthermore, Owner agrees to be held solely responsible for any and all acts and behavior of dog while in care of The Barkley, including payment of costs for injury to staff or other animals or damage to facilities caused directly by the dog. **Owner's Initials:** _____

Owner further understands that dogs play and lead with their teeth and injuries including cuts, scrapes, and puncture wounds can be a result of play and not necessarily aggression. Owner agrees to be responsible for all damages and medical treatment for all injuries to dog. Owner also understands and acknowledges that if an injury is proven to have occurred due to unprovoked aggression, owner of aggressive dog is responsible for medical treatment of injured dog. This includes any emergency exam fees. Owner authorizes dog to be seen by Westlake Village Animal Hospital during their hours of operation or transported and seen by a 24 hour vet hospital in the event The Barkley deems necessary for emergency treatment or doctor's assessment.
